## Description of the workplace

Labyrinth is located close to Bohunice and Stary Liskovec districts of Brno. **We are mainly focused on the art activities as theatre, video, dance, and music.** We have little theatre hall, gym, club and other spaces for our workshops. We cooperate with the students of pedagogy, theatre and music schools in Brno. We also organize some events like seminars, concerts, theatre plays and festivals.

Working time for volunteer will be mainly in the afternoons, sometimes in mornings and occasionally it is useful to participate in some weekend events. Exact schedule depends on the choice of the activities offered.

**We're looking forward to a volunteer who is ready to bring new ideas, new energy and create his / her own projects.**

### The time schedule of the volunteer:

#### 35 hours weekly

- 6 hours per week assist the pedagogues with leisure time activities for children, young people and adults: theatre, dance, video hobby groups, arts group (in the afternoons).
- 2 hours per week assist with lessons of Drama Education for classes of primary and secondary schools (occasionally, in mornings).
- 2 hours per week help with organization and realization of summer and winter camps for children and youth in Labyrinth or out of Brno
- 2 hour per week help with organization of several-day workshops for children, theater, film, music and dance festivals
- 4 hours per week help with organization of activities for the public community: open workshops for children, youth and adults, theatre performances... (once in week, afternoons or evenings)
- 4 hours per week helping in the Labyrinth club. The club works as free space for parents waiting for their children and as an open space for children and youth. It offers board games, table football, darts, place to listen to music, do craft-work, arts etc.
- 2 hours per week help with cleaning, maintenance and operation of Labyrinth
- 2 hours per week managing the promotion of the activities and social media
- 1 hour per week regular meetings with tutor
- 3 hours of Czech language course
- 2 hours of preparation and meetings with coordinator and other volunteers
- 5 hours for volunteers common/personal project

We offer to our volunteers' different kind of support. One of our workers will be your tutor – a guide and adviser who will help you during the whole project. The volunteer will be also provided with all the material of a particular workplace. The volunteer can also visit other activities at Labyrinth or in other branches of Luzanky.

## General description of EVS coordinated by Luzanky:

There are 12 EVS volunteers working at different places on individual projects, meeting every week on common meetings with the coordinator and from time to time with all the colleagues to evaluate and plan the project. Luzanky hosts and coordinates EVS volunteers in other organizations (focused on environmental education, Roma minority, French culture etc.). So, all hosted and coordinated volunteers will meet during the project and can visit workplaces and events of each other.

The volunteers have 3 months Czech language course (60 minutes 2 times a week plus homework). At the beginning of the activity, they are working 5 hours a week together with the coordinator on tasks connected with EVS promotion and presentation of their presence in our organization. Later, usually after 2-3 months, these 5 hours a week can be used by volunteer for his/her own projects and ideas.

Volunteers can visit some of the courses and events organized by Luzanky for free (circus trainings for adults, ceramics etc.).

The organization will host only volunteers older than 18 years old.

**Days off and holidays:** volunteers have 2 days a week free + 2 days per month of vacation. While working occasionally on weekends they have extra days off during the week.

**Allowances:**

Volunteers get their pocket money and food allowance monthly (in the beginning of each month), they are provided with card for Brno public transport.

**Accommodation:**

Volunteers live in rented flats in single rooms.
